

LINKING HIV/AIDS WITH WORLD ENVIRONMENT WEEK

Workplace Programme on HIV/AIDS began its **Health Corner** in tandem with **World Environment Day**, June 5; 2008. Situated on the 7th floor at 25 Dominica Drive (The Towers), this strategy is to be a permanent feature of the programme.
